They include the blood of Angus sires EXT, Rito 6I6 and Papa Equator plus the Simmental influence of Nichols Legacy G151 and Ellingson Legacy M229 "Olie". Also included in this group will be several Angus heifers produced by North Dakota breeders Pete Thompson and his customers with a heavy influence of Spickler, McCumber and Sitz bloodlines. These A.I. bred heifers are due January 28, 2016 and natural service heifers are due February 15 thru March 15. This group of heifers was exposed after A.I. to Final Answer sons and a grandson from Gretsch Brothers Angus. All heifers were preg checked and fetus sexed via ultrasound. (These are red tag heifers).

A.I. bred to Right Answer and then exposed to top calving ease Final Answer sons from McCabe Genetics in Kansas. A.I. bred heifers are due January 28, 2016 and natural service heifers are due February 15 thru March 15. All heifers were preg checked and fetus sexed via ultrasound. (These are white tag heifers).

Shrader Farms purchased 400 weaned heifers in fall 2014 from select commercial producers in North Dakota plus 103 purebred Herefords from the reputable Rausch Hereford Ranch near Hoven, South Dakota. These heifers were developed in a small independent feedyard in North Dakota and then transported to southwest Virginia in early March 2015. In late April, the heifers were bred to proven Genex calving ease sires Bismarck, Right Answer, Victor 719T and Full Power. They were exposed until July 10 to calving ease Angus and/or Polled Hereford bulls. The heifers selling were preg checked and fetal sexed via ultrasound on July 9-10 by embryologist Greg Clements. The 300 heifers selling in this auction will calve A.I. approximately January 28 and natural bred are due February 15 thru March 15, 2016.
